

The Building Stronger Parishes project explored how Catholic parishes, in various contexts, used their strengths and available resources to respond to a variety of challenges. The aim of the research was to identify and analyse some of these initiatives in parishes throughout Australia, which could then be implemented in other parishes facing similar challenges. Particular emphasis was given to stories of vitality and hope that brought life to their communities and had an underlying foundation in an ecclesiology of communion.
